Food packing

All of our volunteer registration takes place online at [fmsc.org](http://fmsc.org). Begin by going to our main webpage at [fmsc.org](http://fmsc.org). LOGIN with your email address and password or click CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT. Click on the white **VOLUNTEER** button in the upper right-hand corner of the screen. This brings you to the VOLUNTEER screen. Next, select a location to search, then choose date and time. When you have successfully registered, you will receive a confirmation email from us.

The minimum age for volunteering is 5 years old. For safety reasons, children under the age of 5 are not allowed to participate in packing sessions. Please note: **Everyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult** (an adult is someone 18 years of age or older).
