Food packing

All of our volunteer registration takes place online at fmsc.org. Begin by going to our main webpage at fmsc.org. LOGIN with your email address and password or click CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT. Click on the white **VOLUNTEER** button in the upper right-hand corner of the screen. This brings you to the VOLUNTEER screen. Next, select a location to search, then choose date and time.
